

The Power of Unforgiveness

I grew up with “trespasses,” not sins, not debts, not offenses. Those words came in later translations. It took a good many years before it occurred to me that I simply have NO choice but to forgive people who have offended me—if I want my Father to forgive me when I mess up. When I mess up, I have offended my heavenly Father.

I realize that Jesus died to pay the price for ALL of my sins, but I need to forgive ALL those people who have offended me. I made a mental list of everyone I could remember:

- that 1st grade teacher who made me stand in the corner because another kid “ratted me out” for something I did NOT do.
- that small group of guys in 7th grade who bullied me.
- that pastor I served under, a megalomaniac that had me so intimidated I stayed afraid.
- that co-worker who put me down at every turn—the list went on and on.

I made a conscious effort to picture each one and speak in my heart, “I forgive you for”

Since that time, I seek to stay “caught up” and make efforts to forgive as soon as it occurs to me.

Are there people who have “done you wrong,” people you need to forgive? Don’t put it off. I know it’s easier said than done, but it is essential that we forgive others if we want our Abba Father to forgive us.



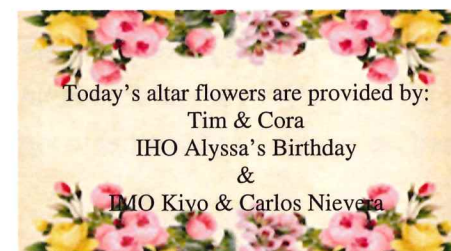
