

Personal Evangelism Commitment Sunday

Les Fogleman turned 82 last November, and the decision to set up a prayer station at the busy intersection by the church he pastors has yielded some of the greatest fruit in his years of ministry.

The idea of a prayer station came to Fogleman when he realized that hundreds of cars drove through the intersection near his church, New Beulah Baptist Church in Hammond, Louisiana, each day.

So, he created signs, built a tall, wooden cross, and sat or walked near the road for a couple hours a day, for three days out of the week.

He had more than 440 people stop and ask for prayer, and his focus on sharing the gospel resulted in 11 baptisms since last June.


Sarah Biggs was saved at the cross and wanted to be baptized. Fogleman and Biggs were able to go to a nearby river where he baptized her in the shallows on a boat ramp.

One young lady stopped by and responded to the gospel. A few days later, she was baptized. Fogleman shared the gospel with her boyfriend: he came to Christ, and Fogleman officiated their wedding ceremony on a weekday morning.

J.J. Washington, National Director of Personal Evangelism at the North American Mission Board, learned of Fogleman's story.

"Churches need to engage their communities, and Les's out-of-the-box thinking has yielded great dividends," Washington said. "His story is a great encouragement for pastors and congregations to find ways to step out of their comfort zones to engage in gospel conversations."
